- ❖ **Hauler will have up to 04/14/18 to complete clean up, however hauler will only do ONE pass of each road**

NOTE: APPLIANCES WILL NO LONGER BE PICKED UP. No commercial contractors or builders!

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:

- Appliances: such as refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, dryers and dishwashers
- Items weighing over 200 lbs., rocks, stones, leaves, logs, brush, grass, slate, concrete, motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts or their components, tires, wheels, gas tanks, propane tanks, water softener tanks, treated wood, metal pipe, barrels, recyclables, hazardous materials or liquid waste, construction material. Wood and materials must be 4' or less in length.
- Electronic Devices: (such as Computer Cases, CPU's, Keyboards, Mice, Monitors, Scanners, Printers, Cables, Laptops, Peripherals, Televisions, Radios, Telephones, Cameras, VCR's, DVD Players, Stereo Components) can be dropped off at the Monmouth County Reclamation Center, 6000 Asbury Avenue, Tinton Falls, NJ 07724. - Wheels, metal pipe and barrels may be dropped off at salvage yards such as Beacon Metals in Freehold and Blewett, Inc. in Howell.

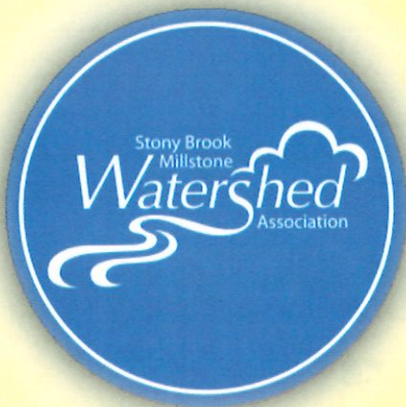

- You were age 65 or older on December 31, 2016, or, if under age 65, you were receiving Social Security disability payments on December 31, 2016, and also on December 31, 2017;
and
- You have lived in New Jersey continuously since December 31, 2006, or earlier, as either a homeowner or a renter;
and
- You have owned and lived in your home or have leased a site in a mobile home park for a manufactured or mobile home that you own since December 31, 2013, or earlier;
and
- You paid all 2016 property taxes by June 1, 2017, and all 2017 property taxes by June 1, 2018;
and
- Your annual income did not exceed \$87,007* in 2016 and \$87,268 in 2017.* *Note:* With few exceptions, all income must be taken into account, including Social Security, pension, etc.

* Eligibility rules, income limits, and benefits may be changed by the State Budget that will take effect on July 1, 2018.
