HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK'S OFFICE:

2023 DOG LICENSES: All dogs 7 months or older are to be licensed each year. The 2023 Dog Licenses can be purchased at the Municipal Building between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday in the Municipal Clerk's Office, Room 105 starting January 3, 2023. Pet license applications and renewals are accepted online through the Spatical Data Logic Portal (see page 2) or mail your fee along with proof of rabies and neutering/spaying to 470 Stage Coach Road, Millstone Twp., NJ 08510. Neutered/Spayed dog fee is \$12.00 and Non-Neutered/Non-Spayed dog fee is \$15.00. A late fee of \$10.00 PER DOG goes into effect May 1, 2023 for all residents who have not renewed their dog's license for the current year.

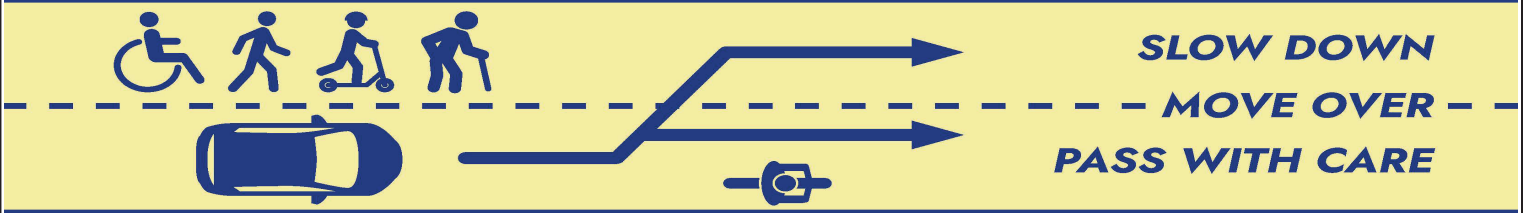

New Jersey's Safe Passing Law

Starting March 1, 2022, when driving and approaching a road user who isn't in a motor vehicle, you must:

- 1** Approach with caution. Follow all no-passing and no-speeding laws. 
- 2** Change lanes, or pass at least **4 feet** from the person. 
- 3** Otherwise, reduce speed to **25mph** and be prepared to stop. 



The penalty for violating the law is a **\$100 fine (\$500 if bodily injury)** and **2 points** on your driving record.



CHRISTMAS TREE PICK UP

Please have trees out **PRIOR** to January 9th

- No artificial trees, wreaths, trimmings or lights
- Please place the tree at curbside, next to your driveway
- Only one pass will be made on each road

Official Notice: To Residents and Businesses of Millstone Township

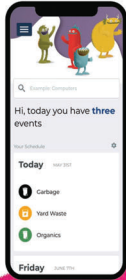
Recycling is mandated by the State, County and Municipal Statutes.

All residents will separate newspapers, glass bottles and jars, tin and bi-metal cans, plastic containers, aluminum cans, corrugated cardboard for collection and ultimate recycling of materials.

Curbside Recycling Guidelines:

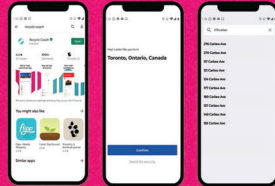
- Residential recycling is to be placed curbside on recycle days only before 6:00 AM. Recyclables should be placed loose in container 32 gallons or smaller. **Please do not place your recyclables in a plastic bag, as they will not be picked up.**

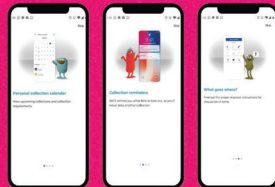

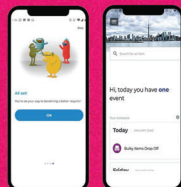

AIM FOR MAXIMIZED RECYCLING



NO
Shredded paper!



- NO** Plastic bags
- NO** Plastics other than #1 and #2 (identified above)
- NO** Plastic (or paper) to-go containers, cups, straws, or utensils
- NO** Plastic film, wrap, or bubble wrap

- NO** Pizza boxes
- NO** Styrofoam of ANY kind
- NO** Frozen food, ice cream, or frozen juice containers
- NO** Organic material or food waste
- NO** Hoses or hangers

DID YOU KNOW?

Many times residents who are concerned about the environment want to recycle properly. However, items such as window glass, plastics that hold personal hygiene products, or other products that manufacturers print with the "recycling triangle", can't be recycled. Placing even a small amount of these items in our recyclables can cause the entire truck load to be rejected. When this occurs the truck is sent to the landfill and none of it is recycled. This is the leading reason why recycling costs are going up.

CURBSIDE SPRING CLEANUP

Monday, April 3, 2023

Maximum allowed per household 5'x 5'x 5' and should be placed curbside no later than 6AM on Monday, April 3, 2023.

Hauler will have up to 4-14-23 to complete cleanup, however hauler will only do one pass on each road.

NO COMMERCIAL CONTRACTORS OR BUILDERS

Items that will NOT be picked up:

Appliances: refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, dryers etc.

Individual Items weighing over 100 Lbs. at the discretion of the vendor.

Rocks, stones, leaves, logs, brush, grass, slate, concrete, etc.

Motor vehicles or motor vehicle parts.

Tires, wheels, gas or propane tanks, water softener tanks, hot water heaters.

Metal pipes or barrels.

Construction material.

Recyclables, hazardous material or liquid waste.

Non-hazardous wood must be 4' or less in length without nails, screws or staples.

Treated wood or painted wood (hazardous material).

Anything in non-transparent plastic bags. **Clear bags only.**

Hazardous materials may be taken to the Monmouth County Reclamation Center by appointment. 732-683-8686

No electronic devices of any type.

Currently electronics may be dropped off at the Millstone Twp. Recycling Yard or at the

Monmouth County Reclamation Center, 6000 Asbury Ave, Tinton Falls NJ 07724. 732-683-8686
