AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO.'S 21-15 & 22-02 AMENDING CHAPTER II (ADMINISTRATION) PAYROLL OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLSTONE BY FIXING SALARY RANGES OF THE TOWNSHIP OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLSTONE, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that it is necessary to amend Ordinance 21-15 & 22-02, which established salaries and fixed compensation of certain Township Employees, by amending the salary ranges for the Building Inspector/Sub-Code Official and adding a provision which allows for payment to Department of Public Works employees that are certified for fertilizer/pesticide applications after the first and last applications of the season.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Millstone, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I. Section I of Ordinance 21-15 & 22-02 be and is hereby amended to provide as follows: (All additions are shown in *bold italics with underlines.*). The deletions are shown as *strikeovers in bold italics*.).

The officials and employees designated shall receive within the annual salary ranges indicated subject to the terms and conditions of employment, for 2022, in accordance with the CWA Contract term, January 2019 through December 2022.

SECTION II. The remainder of Section I of Ordinance 21-15 & 22-02 concerning salary ranges of Township Officials and Employees shall remain unchanged.

SECTION III. Section III of Ordinance 21-15 be and is hereby amended to provide as follows: (All additions are shown in *bold italics with underlines.*). The deletions are shown as *strikeovers in bold italics*.).

Additional salary and wage provisions are as follows:

<u>6) Department of Public Works employees that are certified for fertilizer/pesticide applications</u> shall receive \$375 after the first application of the season and an additional \$375 after the last application of the season.

SECTION IV. The remainder of Section III of Ordinance 21-15 concerning additional salary and wage provisions shall remain unchanged.

SECTION V. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION VI. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final adoption and passage according to law.
