AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLSTONE AND APPROPRIATING \$1,478,646.90 FOR SUCH PURPOSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLSTONE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Township of Millstone, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, authorizes various capital improvements, including the (a) acquisition of equipment including but not limited to zero turn mower and trailer for Department of Public Works; (b) various road and paving improvements, including but not limited to, Stillhouse Road Phase IV between Stagecoach Road and Paint Island Spring Road, parts of Paint Island Spring Road and various roads throughout the subdivisions; and (c) document imaging project, including but not limited to, various document imaging and conversion services of files for the Township of Millstone, to be funded from the sources specified in Section 2 of the Ordinance.

Section 2. The amount of \$1,478,646.90 is hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in Section 1 of the Ordinance and which amount was funded from two grants in the amount of \$209,528 from New Jersey Department of Transportation for Stillhouse Road Phase IV and Paint Island Spring Road, \$244,118.90 from the American Rescue Plan and \$1,025,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the remainder of the improvements, for a total amount of \$1,478,646.90.

Section 3. In connection with the purpose and the amount authorized in Sections 1 and 2 hereof, the Township determines the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement which the Township of Millstone may lawfully make as a general improvement.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon due passage and publication according to law.
