NEW/OLD BUSINESS:

1. Camp/ staff wage (Italiano/Randazzo)

RC/Fenlon – A new staff wage needs to be implemented to adjust for minimum wage and to stay competitive with other programs.

C/Morris – I will send Mike some potential options. We should consider high quality portable scoreboards.
